

# Your baby is counting on you

If you are pregnant and afraid, you need to know that there are safe places for your newborn.

There is an alternative to leaving an infant in an unsafe place.

In Ohio, under the Safe Havens for Newborns law, you can leave your unharmed baby, up to thirty days old, with a medical worker in a hospital, a medical worker at a fire department or other emergency service organization or a peace officer at a law enforcement agency.
